The following week, October 17, Cadillac came here with a powerhouse and ruined our Homecoming, 33-6. Bob Woodruff scored the lone touchdown.

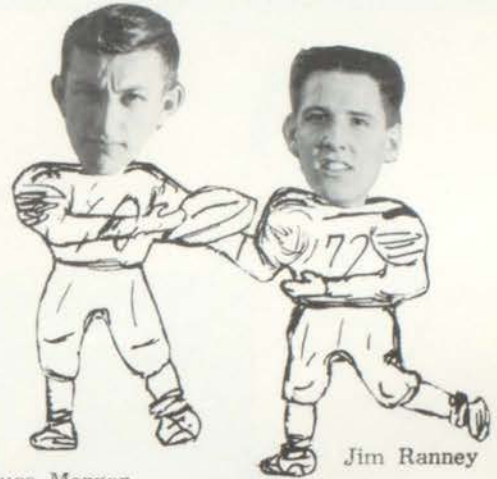
