


 In October, thousands of anti-Vietnam-war protest marchers descended on Washington, D. C. and created scenes like this at the mall entrance of the Pentagon.



































In Review INTERNATIONAL EVENTS


 Israeli soldiers fly their flag from a mosque in the Sinai desert captured by the Israelis during the shortlived Arab-Israeli war in June of 1967.
