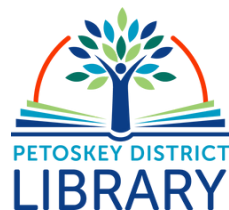
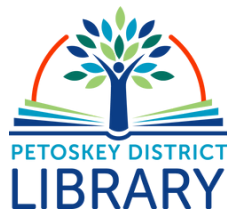


This is Your Place

The Petoskey District Library



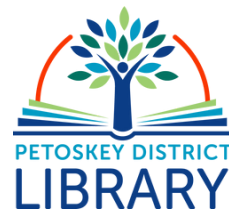
I can enter through the front doors. There are stairs and a ramp



This is the lobby of the library



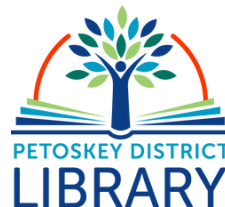
I can turn right to visit the periodicals room or the fireplace lounge

the lower level**



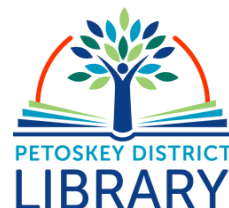
**If I turn right at the stairs, that's

There is a program room for storytime, playgroup, and other events. It can sometimes be loud



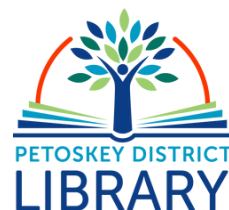
The 2nd floor is a quiet floor with books, materials, and computers for adults



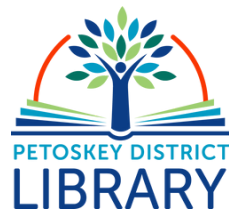
**There is a reference desk on the 2nd
floor where I can ask for help**



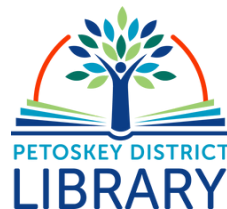
In the lower level I can find bathrooms, the teen space, the Makerspace, and the Friends of the Library bookstore

At the main checkout desk

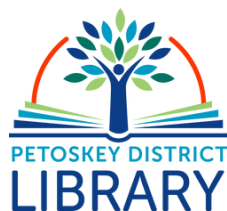

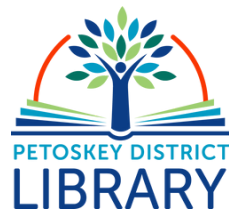


In the alley from Waukazoo Street
