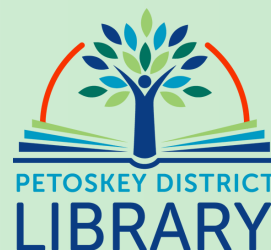

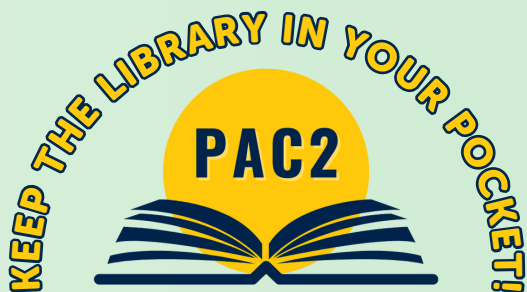
INSTRUCTIONS

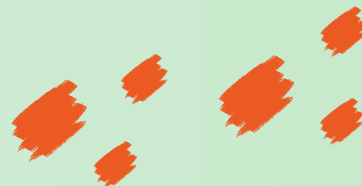
