Face Mask Policy

***Approved: June 25, 2020
October 22, 2020***

It is the policy of the Petoskey District Library to follow the directives of the Health Department of Northwest Michigan and/or Michigan Department of Health and Human Services. While there are directives in place for people to wear face coverings while in indoor public spaces, the Library shall also require the wearing of face coverings while visiting. In support of the health and safety of all those who enter the library, all patrons and staff (except those with a medical condition and children under the age of two) must wear a face mask covering their nose and mouth while in the public areas of the Library. Disposable face masks will be provided for those that do not have their own. For purposes of this policy, "Library" is defined as indoors of both the main library and the Carnegie Building.

Refusing to follow the mask requirement will be considered a violation of the Library's Code of Conduct.
