



Face Mask Policy

Approved: June 25, 2020

Updated: January 27, 2022

It is the policy of the Petoskey District Library to follow the directives of the Health Department of Northwest Michigan and/or Michigan Department of Health and Human Services. If there are directives in place for people to wear face coverings while in indoor public spaces, the Library shall also require the wearing of face coverings for patrons visiting the Library. If there are NO directives in place for people to wear face coverings while in indoor public spaces, the Library shall strongly urge patrons to wear face coverings while visiting. In support of the health and safety of all those who enter the library, all staff shall wear a face-mask covering their nose and mouth while in the public areas of the Library. Disposable face masks will be provided for those that do not have their own. For purposes of this policy, "Library" is defined as indoors of both the main library and the Carnegie Building.

Refusing to follow a mask requirement will be considered a violation of the Library's Code of Conduct.
